

WHEREAS, a Technical Working Group (TWG) was duly constituted from a pool of technical, and legal experts in the National Irrigation Administration (NIA) who shall perform the following functions to assist the Bids and Awards Committee -A (BAC-A) in the procurement of Brand-New Resistivity Instruments, and Core Drilling Equipment:

1. Review of the Technical Specifications, Scope of Work, and Terms of Reference;
2. Review of Bidding Documents;
3. Eligibility Screening;
4. Evaluation of Bids;
5. Post-Qualification; and
6. Resolution of Request for Reconsideration.

Copy of the Memorandum regarding the Creation/Constitution of BAC-A Technical Working Group for the above-mentioned project is attached hereto as **Annex "1"**;

WHEREAS, the BAC-A held a Pre-Procurement Conference on November 27, 2024, to determine the readiness of the procurement of Brand-New Resistivity Instruments, and Core Drilling Equipment. Copy of the minutes of pre-procurement conference is attached as **Annex "2"**;

WHEREAS, the National Irrigation Administration advertised/posted in the PhilGEPS and NIA website (attached as **Annex "3"**) the Invitation to Bid No. NIACOEI-S-4R for the Supply and Delivery of Brand-New Resistivity Instruments, and Core Drilling Equipment on November 29, 2024. The Invitation to Bid was also posted in conspicuous places within the NIA premises;

WHEREAS, in response to said advertisement, SICCIÓN MARKETING, INC. submitted their Letter of Intent (LOI) (**Annex "4"**), and purchased the bid documents;

WHEREAS, observers from the Commission on Audit (COA), Philippine Institute of Civil Engineers (PICE), Philippine Chambers of Commerce, Inc. (PCCI), NIA-Internal Audit Services (NIA-IAS), and National Irrigation Administration Employees Association of the Philippines (NIAEASP), were invited to attend the Pre-bidding Conference scheduled on December 6, 2024; 10:00 A.M. at BAC-A Conference Room, 6th Floor, Building A, NIA Complex, EDSA, Quezon City. Copies of the letters of invitation are hereto attached as **Annexes "5" to "9"**;

WHEREAS, the Pre-bidding Conference held on December 6, 2024 was attended by one (1) prospective bidder, copy of the Minutes of the Pre-Bidding Conference attached as **Annex "10"**;

WHEREAS, observers from the COA, PICE, PCCI, NIAEASP, and NIA-IAS, were all invited to attend the Opening of Bids scheduled on December 18, 2024; 10:00 AM, at BAC-A Conference Room, 6th Floor, Building A, NIA Complex, EDSA, Quezon City;



WHEREAS, SICCIÓN MARKETING, INC. submitted their bid on time, at 4:21 PM of December 17, 2024:

WHEREAS, the bids submitted by SICCIÓN MARKETING, INC. was opened and read in public to determine if they contain all the bid requirements for the Eligibility, Technical, and Financial Components, using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion, copy of the checklist of documents comprising the first envelope of the bid is attached hereto as **Annex “11”**;

WHEREAS, the eligibility, technical, and financial components of the bid submitted by SICCIÓN MARKETING, INC. was rated “PASSED” by the BAC-A, and was informed that the same would be subjected to a detailed bid evaluation, copy of the minutes of the bid opening is attached as **Annex “12”**;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) and the financial bid proposals rated passed by the BAC-A as read in public were tabulated as follows:

The National Irrigation Administration (NIA), through the Government of the Philippines (GOP), Fund 501-LFPs, Project OD-IEC intends to apply the sum of *Sixty-Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php68,500,000.00)*, to payments under the contract for the Supply and Delivery of Brand-New Resistivity Instruments, and Core Drilling Equipment, Invitation to Bid No. NIACOIEC-S-4R. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The NIA now invites bids for the Supply and Delivery of Brand-New Resistivity Instruments, and Core Drilling Equipment, to wit:

Delivery of the Goods is required within Sixty (60) Calendar Days from receipt of the Notice to Proceed. Bidders should have completed a single contract within three (3) years from the deadline of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project with a value of at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.




